A project is typically assessed by two assessors:

- The project owner (PO)
- Topic teacher of the main topic (TT)

The final grade will be determined by combining the criterion grades of the two assessors as below and applying the abovementioned criterion weights:

- Communication PO:TT → 1:1
- Technical depth PO:TT → 0:1
- Method PO:TT → 2:1

Depending on the project, available teachers, and their expertise, we may deviate from these starting points.
