

Software Testing & Risk Assessment 2023: Grade calculation

The final grade is calculated from two components:

1. The **final exam** on April 18th, counting for 70% of the grade;
2. The 5-person **group project report**, due April 18th, counting for 30% of the grade.

For admittance to the exam, the students are required to complete the following tasks:

3. Submit the weekly **homework assignments** in groups of 2. A passing grade is not determined by the correctness of the answers, but by whether the students have made a clear and honest attempt at answering the questions.
4. Submit the weekly **project assignments** with the 5-person project group. A passing grade is not determined by the correctness of the answers, but by whether the students have made a clear and honest attempt at answering the questions.
5. Presence at the **guest lecture** on April 4th.

If any of these tasks cannot be completed due to *force majeure* please contact Milan as soon as possible.

Besides these required tasks, there is also optional material students can use to practice. These will not be graded and do *not* in any way affect your grade:

6. The **non-homework exercises** each tutorial;
7. The **Canvas quizzes** about the videos.
